



Principal's Comment

One of the key concepts that we promote at Liberty is 'responsibility'. Responsibility for our own actions, behaviour, words and thoughts. In Matthew 22:37-38 Jesus reminds us of two great commandments: to love God and to love our neighbour. When we are responsible with our actions, behaviour, words and thoughts we demonstrate our love for God and our love for those around us. At school, this can be as easy as giving an encouraging word to a peer, taking it 'out' in handball, thinking before we speak or remembering to bring a hat to school.
