



Crunch & Sip

Students require fruit and/or vegetables for Crunch & Sip[®] each day. Please consider the size of the item as this is a short time and some children are unable to eat a big apple in the time frame. Pre-cut fruit and vegetables also makes it easier for students. The school is blessed with a supply of fruit from Woolworths for those days that students forget or when items are not available from home.

Kiss & Drop Zone

We appreciate your help in keeping the carpark running smoothly and safely for everyone. Here are some ways to help:

1. If you need to walk into the school, please park in the main carpark.
2. For safety, students must be escorted across the carpark by an adult.
3. Drive to the top of the Kiss & Drop Zone to allow room for other cars to pull in behind. 3 cars can fit comfortably.
4. Stay with your vehicle and staff will supervise students moving to and from the gate to the Kiss & Drop Zone.
5. Move away from this area promptly to maintain a steady flow of traffic.

Remember to pass on these Kiss & Drop procedures to others that help transport your children to and from school.
