Canteen

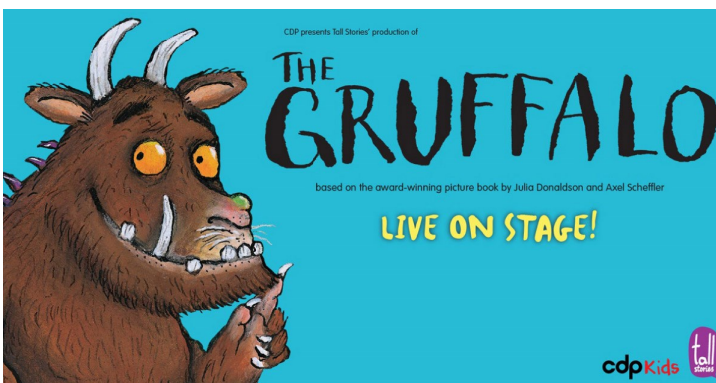

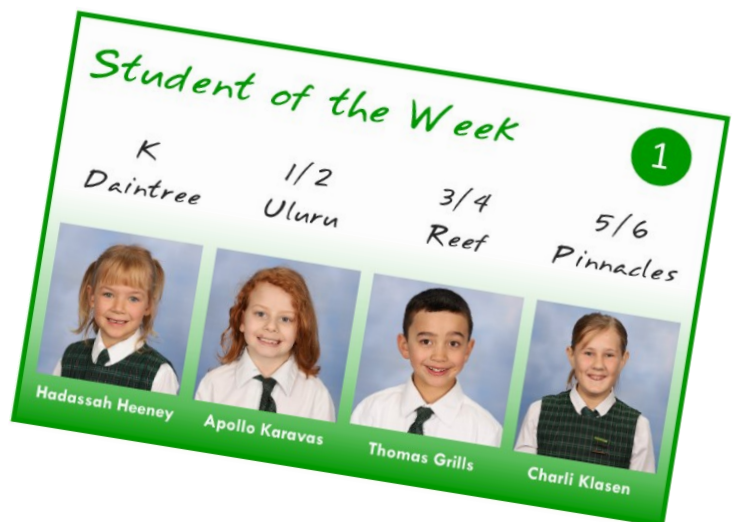
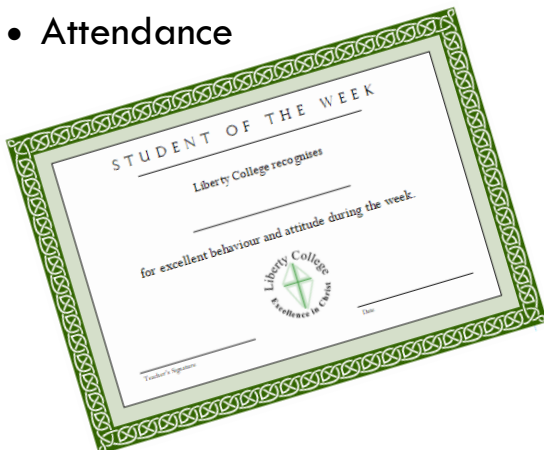
Before School Supervision
